RETURNING TO WORSHIP IN A COVID-19 ENVIRONMENT

BEFORE FRIDAY at NOON



Call the church office at 277-0011 and make a reservation (let us know how many people in your party which will allow us to plan for seating)

BEFORE LEAVING HOME



- Make sure you bring a mask for everyone in your party (you will not be able to enter without one)
- Bring your Bible, hand sanitizer, pen or pencil, and paper for notes
- Make sure everyone in your party goes to the restroom before leaving home
 - * Restrooms will be available for emergency use only
 - * If you must leave the sanctuary to go to the restroom you will not be allowed to re-enter the worship service
- Leave home early

ARRIVING AT CHURCH 9:15



- Use the ramp and enter at the office door
- Make sure you are socially distanced
 - * There will be marks on the ground for social distancing—make sure you (and your party) go to the first available mark and stay there until the next mark becomes available. When the next mark becomes available--move to it.
- The social distancing line will lead to the only entrance in use for the sanctuary by the organ
- When you get to the entrance door stop and wait for further instructions
 - * You will be given a pew number and directed to the aisle to get you into your seat
 - * Each pew has taped off areas to ensure social distancing—stay inside of the taped off area which is highlighted by the sign at each seat
 - * Once you are in your seat—YOU MUST STAY THERE
 - * If you must leave take everything with you as you will not be able to re-enter
- At your seat you can stand and wave to your church family members (No hand shaking or hugs)

DEPARTING THE CHURCH



- At the end of the service everyone must remain in their seat and await further instructions
 - * You will be directed to stand by row number
- When it is your turn to leave, you will be directed to an exit at the back of the sanctuary (the sign at each seat will also point you to the correct exit)
- Have your offerings ready (so you will not have to stop and search for them) and drop them in the plate located through the doors at the back of the sanctuary
- Once you leave the sanctuary immediately exit the building and go to your vehicle (do not linger in the foyers or outside the doors around the building)
